Dear Congregation,

As South Church's Pastoral Search Committee, we're excited to announce that the candidate we've nominated to serve as **our next pastor will be visiting the weekend of January 20-21st - and we hope you'll join us in welcoming her**.

At the beginning of our process, the committee laid out a series of desired qualifications and competencies to ground our search. We decided we were looking for a person of spiritual depth, who's relationally oriented, and committed to engaging our community - and they should be naturally empathetic, curious, and an expert facilitator. A church meeting will be called directly after the service to vote on confirming the candidate's call. Afterwards, the Guild will be hosting a coffee hour/ reception.
